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## APPENDIX 9

### COMPARISON OF HAZARDOUS WASTE GENERATOR REQUIREMENTS

Following is a list of requirements for generators of hazardous waste. The list is a general guidelines for generators of hazardous waste, it should not be used for generator compliance determination. The list does not contain all the requirements nor does it provide specifics of the requirements.

#### Generator Category

##### ◆ Large Quantity Generator

- Generates more than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste per month
- Generates more than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste per month
- Accumulates more than 2.2 lbs of acutely hazardous waste at any one time.

##### ◆ Small Quantity Generator

- Generates between 220 and 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste per month

##### ◆ Conditionally Exempt Generator

- Generates less than 2.2 pounds of acutely hazardous waste per month
- Generates less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month

#### Generator Requirements

##### ◆ Large Quantity Generator

- Identify all hazardous wastes
- Obtain DEQ/EPA hazardous waste identification number
- Properly package wastes
- Properly label and make waste containers
- Accumulate waste on-site for no more than 90 days
- Placard waste for shipment
- Comply with Oregon Department of Transportation's transport requirements
- Use a manifest
- Use a registered transporter
- Prepare emergency contingency plans, emergency procedures and personnel training
- Meet preparedness and prevention requirements

- Keep records and retain for 3 years
- Prepare waste reduction plan
- Follow Land Disposal Restriction regulations and maintain records for 3 years
- Submit annual report to DEQ
- Pay DEQ generator fees

##### ◆ Small Quantity Generator

- Identify all hazardous wastes
- Obtain DEQ/EPA hazardous waste identification number
- Properly package wastes
- Properly label and mark waste containers
- Accumulate waste on-site for no more than 180 days
- Placard waste for shipment
- Comply with Oregon Department of Transportation's transport requirements
- Use a manifest
- Use a registered transporter
- Prepare modified contingency plans, emergency procedures and personnel training
- Meet preparedness and prevention requirements
- Keep records and retain for 3 years
- Prepare waste reduction plan
- Follow Land Disposal Restriction regulations and maintain record for 3 years
- Submit annual report to DEQ
- Pay DEQ generator fees

##### ◆ Conditionally Exempt Generator

- Identify all hazardous wastes
- Send hazardous wastes to regulated hazardous waste facility, recycle wastes or send waste to solid waste management facility
- Never accumulate more than 2,200 pounds of hazardous waste on-site at any time
