2010 Household Hazardous Waste Grants

Application Materials Available: August 1, 2010

Application Deadline: October 15, 2010

(previous September 30, 2010 deadline extended to October 15, 2010)

What Are the Grants?

Oregon law requires DEQ to assess a fee on each ton of domestic solid waste disposed of and, in turn, provide grant funds to local governments for waste reduction and planning projects. This year funding will only be available for Household Hazardous Waste Facility Grants. No funding is currently available for grants supporting solid waste prevention, reuse, and recycling projects. DEQ expects to have \$95,000 available for Household Hazardous Waste Grants this year.

Who Can Apply?

Any **local government responsible for solid waste management** is eligible to apply, including cities, counties, metropolitan service districts, regional parks districts, tribes, sanitary districts, and county service districts.

If you are not a local government, you must contact one well before the deadline to propose working together. Some local governments must get approval from their councils or commissions before applying for a grant, so you may not be able to get approval in time to apply if you wait until near the application deadline to contact the local government.

What Types of Projects Are Eligible

Only Household Hazardous Waste Facilities are eligible to receive DEQ grants.

How to Apply

Application materials are available from your regional technical assistance staff (see list on back), by calling Christie Nuttall 503-229-6832, toll-free in Oregon at 1-800-452-4011, or at www.deq.state.or.us/lq/sw/grants/. Applications must be postmarked by no later than **October 15, 2010**.

How Are Proposals Evaluated?

Proposals must demonstrate their potential for environmental enhancement, ability to continue after funding ends, program commitment, need, cost effectiveness, and ability to measure results.

DEQ Can Assist with the Development of Your Grant Application

We encourage you to work with the technical assistance staff in DEQ regional offices as you develop your funding ideas. They can help ensure that your ideas will be translated into workable projects that are eligible for solid waste grant funds.

If awarded a grant, the local government will enter into a contract with DEQ that specifies the project's schedule, budget, scope of work, and reporting requirements.
