Industrial Stormwater Advisory Committee

- Goals of Draft Permits
 - Protect water quality
 - Technology forcing requirements for facilities that fail to meet benchmarks
 - Monitoring that results in data that is more representative of discharge
 - Streamlined permit that is implementable and easy to understand

- Lay-out of the Permit
 - Faceplate: Effective Date of Permit and Sources Covered
 - Steps for Applying and Renewing Coverage
 - Schedule A: Control Measures, Stormwater Plans and Corrective Actions
 - Schedule B: Monitoring, Inspections and Reporting
 - Schedule D: Definitions
 - Schedule E: Sector Specific Requirements
 - Schedule F: General Conditions



Industrial Stormwater Advisory Committee

March 15, 2011 meeting

- Major Changes to Application requirements
 - Impaired Waters
 - Eligibility requirements for new discharges to impaired waters
 - New and existing facilities will identify receiving stream to determine impairment pollutant monitoring requirements
 - 4th year geometric mean facilities will identify BMPs to achieve new benchmarks and have updated plan stamped by PE



Industrial Stormwater Advisory Committee

March 15, 2011 meeting

- Major Changes in Schedule A:
 - Specific narrative technology based effluent limits- Ex: Housekeeping
 - New requirements for discharges to impaired waters
 - New benchmarks
 - Tiered corrective action requirements
 - Year 2: Tier II facilities will identify BMPs to achieve benchmarks and have plan stamped by PE



Industrial Stormwater Advisory Committee

March 15, 2011 meeting

- Major Changes in Schedule B
 - Monitoring for broader suite of pollutants
 - Benchmarks (statewide and sector specific), Impairment Pollutants and Additional Pollutants
 - Grab composite sampling for 2 years
 - Monitoring during specific times
 - Seasonal first flush sampling
 - Sampling within first twelve hours of event
 - Monthly and annual inspections

March 15, 2011 meeting

- Sector Specific Requirements in Schedule E
 - MSGP requirements
 - Adjusted metals benchmarks based on regional median hardness
