



Oregon Department of Environmental Quality Information Available on Drinking Water Intake Locations

Check for both domestic drinking water sources and private drinking water sources in your targeted mining area. “Private” intakes serve no more than 3 homes, but “domestic or public” water systems serve 4 or more homes.

Domestic or Public Drinking Water Sources

Domestic or Public Water System Drinking Water Source Areas are shown in “Facility Profiler” on DEQ’s website. You can get to the Facility Profiler by going to <http://www.oregon.gov/DEQ/> then navigate to “Databases” then “Facility Profiler” or use direct link of <http://deq12.deq.state.or.us/fp20/>.

Below are the steps to view and identify source water areas using Facility Profiler

- Navigate to site of interest using “Search by” tools
- On right sidebar under “Map Features” select “Show Advanced” then check “DW Source Ground” and “DW Source Surface” then Refresh Map
- Lime Green “circles” are Drinking Water Source Areas for Public Water Systems served by groundwater wells or springs
- Orange vertical-hatched areas are Drinking Water Source Areas for Public Water Systems served by surface water intakes
