Dear Mr. Dearden:

As provided to you our letter dated September 17, 2014 in response to comments received from StarLink Logistics LLC (StarLink) on April 25, 2014, the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has prepared the attached RI/SCE Report Addendum. This Addendum, along with the RI/SCE Report and the Supplemental Section 8 represents the full and DEQ approved Remedial Investigation Report for the upland portion of Rhone-Poulenc-Portland Site (the Site).

This Addendum serves to define the extent of known contamination at the Site. However, the Addendum also acknowledges that additional risk and site characterization assessment will be required in order to develop a comprehensive feasibility study (FS) before a final remedy is selected for the Site.

DEQ anticipates that we will complete our review and provide comments on the following risk evaluation documents within the next 60 days:

- Revised Final Human Health Risk Assessment (On-property only), June 25, 2012
- Off-Property Screening Level Human Health Risk Evaluation, October 7, 2013
- HDD Soil Human Health Risk Evaluation and Preliminary Hot Spot Evaluation Summary, September 13, 2013

Once our final approval of these documents is complete, DEQ plans move expeditiously to complete a FS Work Plan, and establish a efficient schedule to complete the FS and a selected remedy for the Site under a Record of Decision.
