SUMMARY

CWM will be submitting a revision to the 10-year permit application that we submitted to DEQ in 2016. This resubmission of the original application includes the renewal of the existing permit (ORD 089 454 353) and the addition of treatment and disposal units. The additional units are needed to ensure adequate capacity and functionality for the next permit cycle and beyond. CWM's proposal also contains other changes, including modifications to address current regulatory conditions.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

Attend the CWM public meeting to learn about our proposed permit renewal and ask questions. After DEQ receives the revised permit application from CWM, DEQ will post the application for public review, and host a separate DEQ public hearing to collect verbal and written comments.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

CWM has operated in Gilliam County since 1976, providing treatment and safe disposal for industrial and hazardous waste. The facility is engineered with overlapping environmental protection systems that meet or exceed rigorous state and federal regulations. CWM is subject to highly regulated monitoring and reporting requirements to verify that environmental protection systems are operating properly.
